Deforestation is the transformation of forested areas into non-forested land to make room for pasture, urban use, agriculture, or wasteland. Most commonly, deforestation is associated with the permanent destruction of significant areas of forest cover that results from illegal



logging or unsustainable practices such as felling of trees for firewood and building material.

Currently, 32 million acres of forests or woodlands are cleared annually. At this rate, significant

moist tropical forests (often called the lungs of the Earth) could be lost by the year 2050. A degraded forest environment has implications not only to biodiversity and habitats, but also to people's quality of life.



Recycling Paper Saves Trees

Paper recycling is the process of recovering waste paper and remaking it into new paper products, sparing new trees from being harvested. It has been estimated that recycling half the world's paper would avoid the harvesting of 20 million acres of forestland.

There are three categories of paper that can be used for making recycled paper: mill broke, pre-consumer waste, and postconsumer waste. Pre-consumer waste is material which left the paper mill, which has been discarded before it was ready for consumer use. Post-consumer waste is material discarded after consumer use, such as old magazines, old newspapers, and residential mixed paper. Mill broke is paper trimmings and other paper scrap from the manufacture of paper, and is recycled internally in a paper mill.

Since we cannot recover all the pulp needed to make the paper we consume, recycled paper must be supplemented with certified paper.

Not all recycled paper is green. Some is mixed with paper that comes from devastated forests.
